[SP] denotes a rule for which the race committee may apply a standard penalty without a hearing or a discretionary penalty may be applied by the international jury with a hearing. However, a boat may be protested if the standard penalty is inappropriate. A boat that has been penalized with a standard penalty shall not request redress for this committee action. This changes RRS 60.1, 63.1 and A5.

DELETE AND REPLACE WITH:

UF3.5 (d) A yellow flag with a long sound means "The umpires have not the facts to take a decision"

UF5.3 A boat intending to

- (a) protest another boat under a rule other than rule UF3.6 or rule 28, or a rule listed in rule UF3.3(a),
- (b) protest another boat under rule 14 if there was contact that caused damage or injury, or
- (c) request redress

shall inform the race committee in the following way:

- 1- For incidents in the racing area: At the Race Office, within the Protest Time Limit, which will be set by and posted on the ONB by the International Jury.
- 2- For all other requests: At the Race Office, as soon as reasonably possible after learning of the reasons for making it.

This changes rule 61.3 and 62.2.

SI 1.3 – Not carrying the tracking device. SI 1.3 – Not attaching the tracking device in the required position. SI 1.3 – Not returning the tracking device on the required date. SI 1.3 – Tampering with the tracking device	Two point scoring penalty added to the closest race to the infringement.
SI 2 – Not displaying bow number sticker. SI 2 – Not displaying sponsor sticker.	Two point scoring penalty added to the closest race to the infringement.
SI 4.3 – Leaving the harbour while AP over H has been displayed ashore	Five point scoring penalty added to the closest race to the infringement.
SI 18.1 – Not equipped with the required VHF transmitter	Two point scoring penalty added to the closest race to the infringement.
SI 24.1 – Not being afloat and in the designated mooring position by the date and time required. SI 24.1 – Being hauled out without prior written permission of the Race Committee	Two point scoring penalty added to the closest race to the infringement.
